

BACKYARD COMPETITOR INFORMATION –

Set up 7am to 9am Saturday, August 21st (vehicles/trailers moved away from cooking area by 9am).

Enter fairgrounds from 1st Street. South at stoplight on Route 24. Staging area marked. Fair member will lead team to competition area.

Team/cooks assemble @ 9:15am @ AGAR of Rantoul display for meeting

Will proceed to judging building at this time with a team member (don't need everyone). Suggest timing this distance

Chicken turn in 2:00 pm to 2:15 pm (any part may be used, typically leg, thigh, breast or quarters...wings maybe, necks doubt it)

Rib turn in 2:45 pm to 3:00 pm. MUST prepare/use the 4 FREE SPARE RIB RACKS provided!

Awards approx 4:45 @ AGAR of Rantoul display

Entry fee \$50 ONLY 20 TEAMS. Will refund entry fee if contest is cancelled or if entry is after first 20 entries received.

Payouts (both meats) - 1st 425.00 + award, 2nd 225.00 + award, 3rd 125.00 + award, 4th 100.00, 5th 50.00

Best Display (public vote) 150.00 + award OVERALL CHAMPION Large Big Green Egg + award

20 TEAM LIMIT. POSTMARKS to be used for eligibility. Enter early!

KCBS Backyard rules apply. Make sure YOU know them. SOME rules below –

NO pro teams allowed, no pro team help during contest

Turn in containers provided at 9:15 am team meeting

No exterior alterations/markings allowed. Number assigned by KCBS representative MUST NOT be altered and MUST be displayed on TOP of container

No pre-marinating chicken allowed

Chicken inspected prior to seasoning/cooking to insure in raw natural state

FREE SPARE RIB RACKS handed out at 9:15 am team meeting

Garnish/sauce is optional. Do what you think

6 portions per container. For spare ribs make sure EACH portion is cut through for ease of judging. Ribs may be single or double bones

6 judges per table

Overall (Grand) Champion will be a combination of your chicken and rib scores

Electricity NOT available

Quiet generators allowed (will shut down if too loud/or complaints)

Proper extension cords a must.

Pre marked/assigned 10W' x 24L' area (approx). Generators MUST be placed farthest away from public, along fence. NO EXCEPTIONS!

No structures other than 10' x 10' awning

Potable water available nearby

Metal trash cans provided for ashes. MUST USE

Team area must be clean at end of contest. Do not burn grass!

Any type of grill or cookers may be used. No gasoline or charcoal lighter allowed

Please decorate your area. Prize given for best display. Public voting

Teams responsible for all of their own needs, no help provided for load in or load out

Vehicles/trailers must be parked away from contest area. Parking nearby

Please keep meat at proper temperature (below 40 degrees) prior to cooking. PROPER FOOD HANDLING SANITATION A MUST!

Only alcohol purchased on fairgrounds allowed on property.

Please keep alcohol out of public view. "Red Cup" policy will be enforced.

YOU are responsible for your team and/or your guest's actions.

Any violations will be subject to disqualification. NO refunds
