THIS IS MEANT TO BE A FUN KIDS ONLY EVENT. DO NOT LET BELOW RULES “SCARE” KIDS OFF!!!!

10 entries per age group ONLY. Ages 6 thru 10 & 11 thru 15. POSTMARKS used for eligibility. Enter early!

Set up 1pm to 1:30 pm Saturday, August 20th

Enter fairgrounds from 1st Street. South at stoplight on Route 24

Due to fair being open to public at this time -

Wait in posted area. Be there by 12:15 pm!!!!

Fair member will lead teams/vehicle to assigned load out area. No help provided

Team meeting @ 1:30pm @ cooking area

Any type of grill may be used. Heating source must come from wood, charcoal or pellets

Pork products used will be given out FREE of CHARGE at meeting courtesy of STEIDINGER FOODS!!

Pork burger (you make from ground pork) turn in 2:50 pm to 3:00 pm. Begin cooking accordingly

Pork center cut loin chop turn in 3:20 pm to 3:30 pm. Begin cooking accordingly.

Child/cook must be standing in the “turn in area” at the proper time. “Turn in area” will be given at team meeting.

4 samples must be submitted for judging. Turn in your best!

Styrofoam turn in containers provided will be numbered and can’t be altered

Awards approx 4:45 pm @ AGAR of Rantoul display

NO ENTRY FEE

Age group 6 thru 10 will use provided GROUND PORK to make into pork burgers

Age group 11 thru 15 will use provided PORK CENTER CUT LOIN CHOP

Garnish/sauce is optional. Do what you think

KCBS rules apply. Make sure YOU know them

Child/cook must do everything. If they can’t, they’re too young to cook

Parent/guardian may assist with fires and cutting/slicing

Special needs children ARE welcome!

They will be allowed to do as much as they are able to

Some help from their parent/guardian is permissible

No electric. No generators allowed

Each team will have an approx 10 x10 area to use. Plan accordingly

Team area must be clean at end of contest. Do not burn the grass

Metal trash cans provided for hot coals/ash. MUST USE

Potable water nearby. PROPER FOOD HANDLING SANITATION A MUST!

Each team responsible for what they need to use, such as -

Grill, utensils, tables, food service gloves, rubs, sauces etc

ONLY one child cook and one parent/guardian allowed in their area

Child cook must remain in their area at all times during contest

Parent/guardian must remain in their area at all times during contest

Judging based on appearance, taste, tenderness/texture

Scoring from 9 (highest) to 1 (lowest). Highest total is winner

Entries do not have to be affiliated with a Backyard team that is competing

Absolutely NO alcohol in your cooking area
