

Fairbury Fair Camping Rules

August 15-20, 2023

- All campers must enter through gate 1, at the south end of 1st street.
- Campers will not be allowed in before 4 pm on Tuesday, August 15th. Exceptions will ONLY be made for livestock exhibitors.
- If payment was not made in advance, and you are not an exhibitor that has paid along with your exhibit entry, please go to the following link, upon arrival, to pay for camping.

- No refunds on camping permits will be given.
- All PETS must be leashed and kept away from livestock at all times! **NO EXCEPTIONS!** The Fairbury Fair will not be held responsible for harm to your pet resulting in failure to follow this rule.
- There are **NO** hookups for campers.
- All campers must have wood under their camper jacks.
- Only quiet generators are allowed.
- QUIET TIME** for the weekend will be from **12 am to 7 am**.
- Campfires will be allowed, on FALS property campsites, but ONLY in raised fire pits. Please dispose of your ashes in metal barrels around the grounds.
- Please dispose of your own garbage in bins or dumpsters placed around the camping area.

PLEASE BE RESPECTFUL OF OTHERS AROUND YOU AT ALL TIMES! The Fairbury Fair is not responsible for lost or stolen items. It is your responsibility to secure your camping area for the weekend. Failure to obey camping rules, regulations and respect for the property will result in loss of privileges and you may be asked to leave.

GOLF CART RULES

ON PROPERTY

- All drivers must be at least 16 years of age. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- No dangerous driving, riding, or shenanigans allowed on the fairgrounds/FALS property. Any golf carts caught participating in these behaviors will be parked for the remainder of fair week, no matter who the driver was when the offense was committed.
- No 4-wheeler, "gator", side by side or motorbike type vehicles are allowed on the grounds during fair week, unless authorized by the fairboard.
- Golf carts will not be allowed on the midway, unless authorized by the fairboard.
- A reasonable, slow (approximately 5mph) speed limit will be enforced at all times.
- No golf carts will be allowed anywhere that it is posted, "NO GOLF CARTS", unless authorized by the fairboard.

CITY OF FAIRBURY

No golf carts are allowed on 1st street, 7th street or Highway 24 unless posted otherwise. Please refer to the following link for city rules governing golf cart usage.
